PALMAROSA (COMOROS)

BOTANICAL CLASSIFICATION *Cymbopogon martinii var. martinii* is a species of the Gramineae family. Not to be confused with the closely related gingergrass, known as *Cymbopogon martinii var sofia*, which is a different chemotype.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION A wild growing grass with very fragrant leaves. The grass is harvested before it flowers and is dried for a week before distillation to give the best oil. The pale, yellow mobile liquid has a rosy, geranium like aroma.

ORIGIN A native of India and Pakistan it can now be found in Brazil, the Comoros, Java and the Seychelles. The oil produced in the Seychelles has a softer aroma.

GAS LIQUID CHROMATOGRAM The key components of Natural Touch's essential oil type confirm that it is the high quality, true Palmarosa and not gingergrass or a combination of the two. This is indicated specifically by the high geraniol content which is significantly lower in gingergrass.
